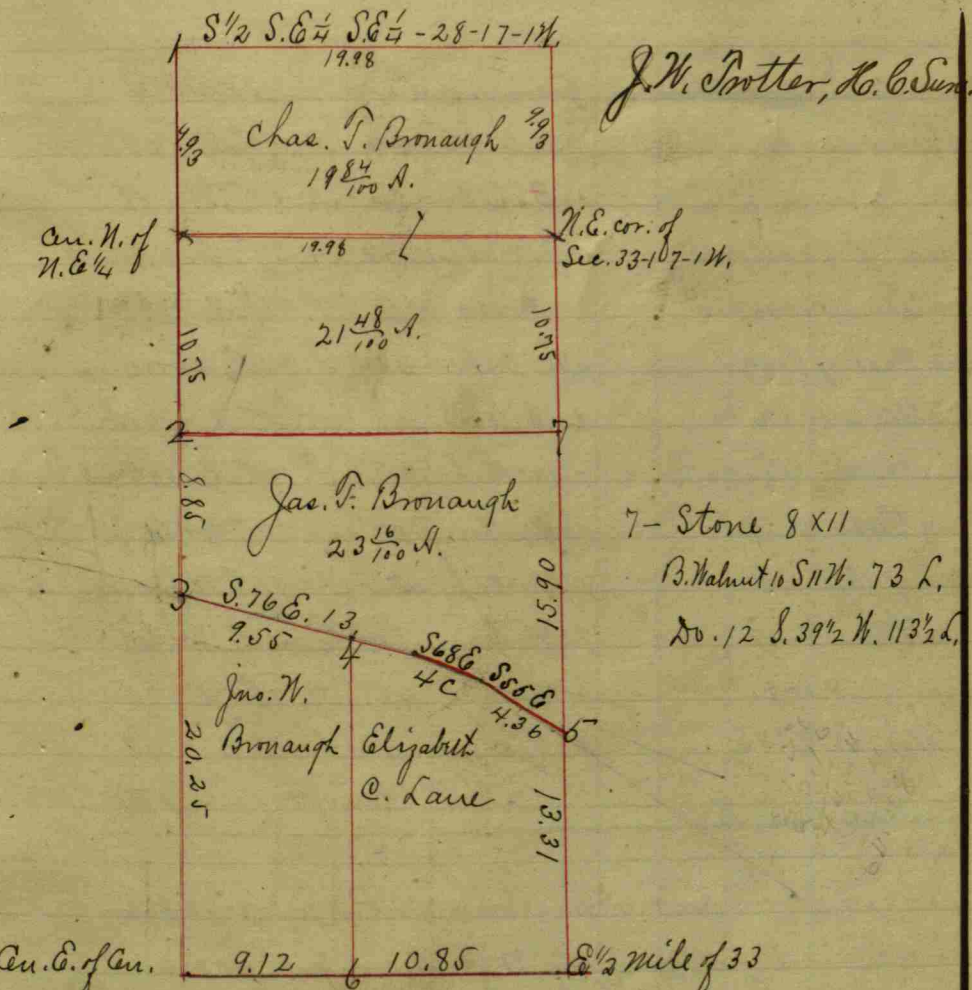


Plat of the Partition of these Videl Lands, in Sec. 28 & 33.



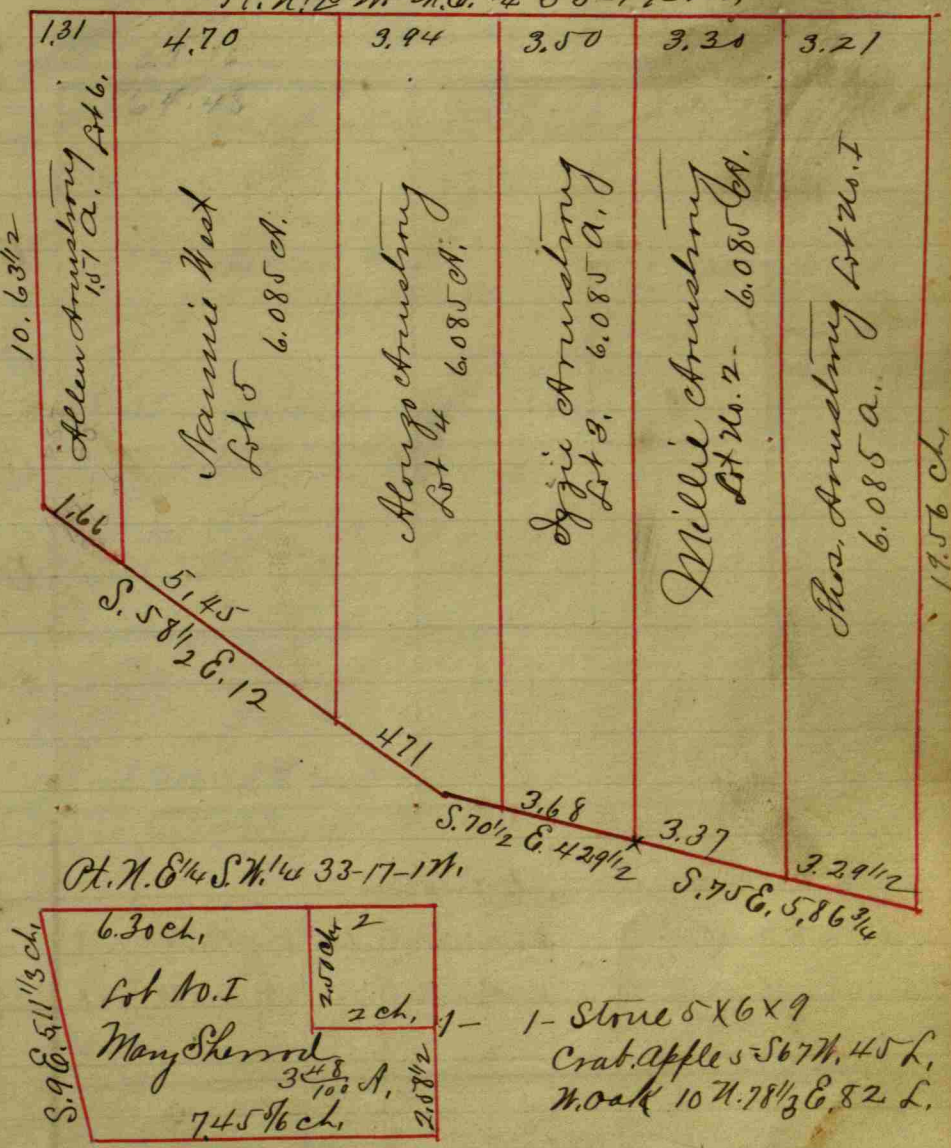
