John, the second son, was taken by a family who later moved to Kansas. There John lived until he was about twenty years of age when he again joined the family circle.

James second wife was Cynthia Ann Bloomfield and to this union also were born five children, two of whom died in infancy. The mother died when David Thomas was a small baby.

James third wife was Eliza Ann Elkins Kefauver and to this union were born five children all of whom died in infancy. By a former marriage Eliza Ann had two children --- Francis Marion and Mollie Mae.

In 1883 James moved his family from Illinois to Indiana and spent the remainder of his life in that state residing near Indianapolis.

James was born July 25, 1848 and died July 4, 1917 of Smallpox.

From that time until her death October 10, 1928 Eliza Ann made her home with her daughter.
