Recovered and Marked

Dear Neil:

We propose to find and positively identify as many of the ten original corner monuments as may be possible. Lost and/or obliterated corners will be restored by our firm and monumented with standard county metal caps mounted on a suitable steel post or set in a concrete footing, whichever is most feasible. The taking of references to nearby objects to perpetuate the corners will be our responsibility.

The Airport Authority wishes to make the monuments readily accessible by placing some kind of casting with removable cover over each one. I suggest that it furnish the labor and material for that work at its own expense, and that Hendricks County sponsor the recovery, identification, restoration of missing corners by surveying and marking, taking of references, full-time overseeing of the casting placement, and the drawing to plats for your Corner Record Books. All work by our firm shall be performed in conformity with our contract with you.

Our overseeing of the placement of castings will assure that any monument location accidentally disturbed will be corrected before the work is completed. The Airport Authority would have to let us know in advance when it proposed to set the castings.
