The facilities of record offered by this register adapt it to the wants equally of those who aim to record final results only, and of those who desire to keep a comprehensive and minute record. It is flexible, and may be adjusted to any system of keeping school records.

MODEL.

1. Make all entries with pen and ink.
 2. Give each pupil a *number* when he enters school. Use this number in all the Records wherever his or her name appears, and do not use the same number for any other pupil during the school year.
 3. Do not enter the names of the pupils in this book (unless they have already been classified) until the first examination has been held, then write them in *groups* with reference to *grade*. Write the names of those belonging to the *first grade*, then write the names of those belonging to the next higher grade, and so on, until the names of all the pupils in the respective grades have been registered; after which, write the names of the *ungraded* pupils (pupils pursuing studies in more than one grade). It will be found convenient to leave space of two or three lines between each grade.
 - When the grades are divided into classes, the classes may be indicated in the following manner: If the grades and classes are indicated by numbers, then for grade 5, class 1, write 5¹; grade 5, class 5², etc. If the grades are indicated by letters and the classes by numbers, then for grade A, class 1, write A¹; grade A, class 2, A², etc. If both are indicated by letters, then for grammar department, grade A, write G^a; grammar department, grade B, G^b, etc. Write for ungraded.
 4. When a pupil enters after the beginning of the term, write in the space for his day of entrance; W for his withdrawal,* and for re-entrance. These letters, E, W and R, are to be written in the upper part of the attendance section, for forenoon's entrance, withdrawal and re-entrance; in the lower part for entrance, withdrawal and re-entrance in the afternoon. Illustration—William Motsinger entered on Monday morning of the second week, was absent three consecutive days of the next week, and re-entered on Tuesday afternoon of the week following. Esse C. Bissell withdrew Thursday afternoon of the second week, and re-entered Monday morning of the third week.
 5. Record *absence* only. In the forenoon, by a slanted stroke to the right, thus \; in the afternoon, by a slanted stroke to the left, as /. Absence in both forenoon and afternoon, by a cross X. Illustration—Dora M. Jennings was absent Monday forenoon and Thursday afternoon of the second week of school, and all day Tuesday of the third week.
 6. Write the number of minutes tardy in the lower part of the section for the day on which it occurred. Illustration—Oscar B. Mayfield was tardy 10 minutes on Monday of the second week of school, and 15 minutes on Thursday of the third week.
 7. Enter demerit marks for irregular deportment, in the upper part of the attendance section. When a pupil's deportment is perfect, leave the space blank; for imperfect deportment, give demerit marks from 1 to 5, inclusive.
 8. Each pupil's "Per Cent of Attendance" for the month is found by dividing the number of half-days present by the number of half-days he was a member of school during the month. Thus—William Motsinger was present 7 half-days, and absent 4 half-days, making him a member of school 11 half days. $7 \div 11 = 63.7$, or 64, his per cent of attendance for the month.
 9. To get the "Punctuality," consider the pupil's chances to be during the month equal to the number of half-days he actually
 - attended, then proceed as follows: From the number of half-days' attendance take the number of times tardy, and divide the remainder by the number of half-days' attendance. Thus—Oscar B. Mayfield was present 40 half-days and tardy 2 times. $40 - 2 = 38$. $38 \div 40 = .95$, his punctuality.
 10. To find the "Deportment," subtract the sum of the demerit marks from 100.
 11. The "General Average" is an average of the four items, viz: "Per Cent of Attendance," "Punctuality," "Deportment," and "Average Scholarship." The purpose of this average is to give every pupil a chance to rank high. If a pupil cannot attain a high scholarship, he can rank high in his grade by making his attendance, punctuality and deportment perfect.
 12. "Rank in Grade" is based on the General Average. The pupil having the highest general average is entitled to the "1st" rank in his grade. The pupil having the next highest general average in his grade should be given the "2d" rank, and so on, with all the members of any grade.
 13. Under "Days Absent," report only the number of days the pupil was absent while a member of school. Do not report the number of days before he entered school, nor after he withdrew from school.
 14. The "Average Daily Attendance" for the month is found by dividing the whole number of days' attendance by the number of days taught. The "Average Daily Attendance" for the "Term or Year" may be found in the same manner, or by dividing the sum of the averages for the several months by the number of months taught.
 15. To find the "Per Cent of Attendance" for the term or year, divide the whole number of days of attendance by the whole number of days of attendance plus the whole number of days of absence.
 16. Under "Remarks" for the month, give a brief explanation of points not otherwise shown in the pupil's record.
 17. The "No. Enrolled During the Year" need not be reported until the report is made for the *final* term of the year.
 18. In the form for "Teacher's Report to Successor," the names of pupils should be written in the same order as in the Register, with particular reference to the *number* and *grade* of each pupil. In each section (or square space) at the right of the pupil's name, under the heading "Page to Begin Next Term," write the number of the page at which the pupil may resume his work in that branch the subsequent term. Should a pupil be irregular in his studies (pursuing studies in different grades) write the number of the grade to which the study belongs in the *upper* part of the section for such study. In case a pupil has not taken *all* the studies of his grade, indicate the omission by making a cross X in the section under the branch omitted.
 19. Under "Remarks," on the page for "Daily Programme," make such suggestions concerning the respective grades as will be of benefit to the incoming teacher, observing the foregoing directions.

NOTE 1. *A pupil should not be considered a member of school after he has been absent three consecutive days.

NOTE 2. +When a fraction less than $\frac{1}{2}$ occurs in getting averages, drop it; if it is equal to or greater than $\frac{1}{2}$, consider it 1.

The report of the Enumeration in this book should be made by the Trustee each year before the school opens.
