Hon. Gentlemen:

We are proceeding, as per your order, to install thirty-four (34) post lights around the Public Square in Danville to be arranged and burn as follows:

There will be 12 - 250 C.P. Edgewater post units located on the inside of the square evenly spaced around the Court House yard. These lamps to burn from sunset to sunrise every night.

There will be 20 - 250 C.P. Edgewater Post units located on the outside of square, four (4) evenly spaced on each side and one located on each outer corner. These lamps to burn from sundown to midnight.

There will be 4 - 100 C.P. Solux Gate Post Newel Standards located in street intersection of the four (4) corners around public square. These lamps to burn from sundown to sunrise.

Upon the basis of all other street lighting, the Merchants Heat & Light Company will install and own the equipment and charge the town a service and rental fee of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars per year, or One Hundred Sixty-Six and 66/100 (\$166.66) Dollars per month.

The division of the expense between the County and Town to be left to their discretion.

Gentlemen:-

In compliance with an order of the Town Board of Danville Indiana. In special session September 11-1922, you are hereby requested and empowered to erect street lights located as follows, (See plan Exhibit "A" attached hereto). These lights to be 100 C.P. Nitrogen gas filled, suspension type with radial reflectors.

- 1-100 C.P. At North Jefferson where Jefferson turns North east to Washington.
- 1-100 C.P. Intersection of Columbia & Wayne.
- 1-100 C.P. Intersection of Columbia and 1st Street East of Wayne.
- 1-100 C.P. Equal distance between intersections of Columbia & Cross and Clinton & Cross.
- 1-100 C.P. Intersection of North & Tennessee.

These lights to be 250 C.P. Nitrogen gas filled, suspension type with radial reflectors and bowl refractors.

- 1-250 C.P. Intersection of Columbia & Indiana.
- 1-250 C.P. Intersection of Clinton & Jefferson.

Further, you are hereby requested and empowered to move the following lamps, and change candle power as noted.

- 1-400 C.P. now installed approx. 350 feet south of Broadway and Cross to location approx. 500 feet south of Mill & Cross. This to be 100 C.P. nitrogen gas filled lamp with radial reflector.
- 1-400 C.P. now located approx. 600 feet south of Mill & Cross on Cross to location approx. 1250 feet south of Mill & Cross on Cross. This to be 250 C.P. nitrogen gas filled lamp with radial reflector and bowl refractor.
- 1-400 C.P. now located approx. 320 feet north of Klondike and Kentucky to approx. 500 feet north of Klondike and Kentucky on Kentucky. This to be 100 C.P. nitrogen gas filled lamp with radial reflector.

The burning of all lamps to be based upon rates and conditions as set out in contract now in force.

In requesting and ordering installation of new lamps and change of candle power of lamps now installed do hereby grant an extension of contract now in force for a period of five (5) years, as set out in clause of contract, (TERM OF CONTRACT) as follows.

This contract shall be in full force an effect for a period of five (5) years from October 1st, 1919. Any change of consequence from this selected schedule after the first years operation, shall open up a question as to whether an extension of the term of the original contract shall be required by the Company, or the expiration date left as originally established. This is made necessary for the reason that depreciation is a factor of consequence in different types of installation and may have a bearing upon the length of contract. During the term set out, this contract shall be binding and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, their successors or assigns respectively.

Should the Town desire to make any change in the location of any lamp, after schedule has been selected and lamps placed, then the Company shall make an estimate of the cost of such change, the alteration, if any in the rates and present same to the Town Board for their approval. When approved by the Board the Company shall make the change and the Town shall draw a warrant in favor of the Company for the actual construction cost minus any materials that would be required and covered by the rate charge as noted herein.
