The principal of this bond shall be due and payable at the option of the holder on mon payment after due presentation, fany of said coupons for minety days after maturity thereof.

Gregory John & Vestal and Robert & Parker the Commissioners of Hendrick's County, in the State of Indiana, are hereby authorized to signall coupons in lithograph.


