






















NORTH BELVILLE



A plat and description of The Town of North Belville laid out for George W. Hammonds by Job Hadley, H. C. Surveyor 3rd Month 14th.

The above town is situated in the South East quarter of Section thirty five in Township fifteen North Range One West in Hendricks County, Indiana as follows. Beginning at the centre of the section, thence East with the line (at 5° variation) thirty four poles where a beech 18 inches bears North 33° West 89 links and do 16 inches bears North 5° West 87 links, thence South 22° East 18 poles and 2 links, thence South 68° West 40 1/8 poles where a B. Oak 36 North 65° West 14 links, thence North (at 5 3/4°) with the line 27 poles and 9 links to the beginning containing by estimation five acres and twenty nine square poles.

The lots as shown on the plat are on the South of the Rail road except the depot lot which is as follows. Beginning at the centre of the Section, thence East with the line 34 poles, thence South 22° East 1 3/4 poles, thence South 68° West with the centre of the rail road to the west line of the quarter section, thence North 10 poles to the beginning containing 1 acre and twenty five square poles more or less.

Railroad street on the South of the centre of the rail road is 50 feet. Centre Street is 60 feet, West street on the North is 20 feet at the South end is 86 feet. All alleys are 12 feet and all lots are 60 feet East and West and 100 feet North and South and are all laid of f and numbered as shown on the plat.

I Simon T. Hadley the Recorder in and for said county certify that George W. Hammond the Proprietor of the Town of North Belville above described came personally before me and acknowledged the laying of the above described town and the fieldnotes of the same as above to be his act and deed for the uses and purposes therein expressed.
